
MASTER'S WEEKEND in Palma de Mallorca

The city of Palma, established by the Romans in 123 BC upon the remains of a Talaiotic settlement, was subjected to several Vandal raids, re-conquered by the Byzantine Empire, taken over by the Moors who called it Medina Mayurqa and finally re-conquered in 1229 by King James 1 of Aragon.

Day 2 (Friday)

Visit to LaFiore

LaFiore is a team of creators, designers and lovers of the products hand made in Mallorca. It continues to renew the tradition of artistic glass and crafts with an infinite range of colours and shapes. We will visit the factory and watch masters of traditional blown glass at work.

Dinner at Ca n' Eduardo

Day 3 (Saturday)

Visit to Capvespre Centre

Capvespre is a co-operative information centre giving information and teaching on traditional methods of cultivation of olives and oranges in Mallorca. We will be learning about the growing of olives, the production of olive oil and the production of crushed olives.

Visit to the Carthusian monastery

The Carthusian Monastery of Valldemossa was originally a royal residence until Carthusian monks occupied the building from 1399 until 1835. After the expulsion of the monks individual cells became available for rent. One of the cells comprising of 3 large rooms and a garden was occupied by Frederick Chopin and the writer George Sand with her family during the winter of 1838-1839.





Walking tour of Palma

Walking tour of Palma to include a visit to the famous Mercat de l'Olivar and the Catedral-Basilica de Santa Maria de Mallorca, more commonly known as La Seu. During the tour we will sample some of Mallorca's culinary delights.



Dinner at Son Llompart

The Macià Batle family, who has the oldest wine making tradition in Mallorca dating back to 1470, owns finca Son Llompart. Our dinner will be catered by Fosh Catering (Marc Fosh's restaurant in Palma has a Michelin star) and the wines will be from Son Llompart Macià Batle.

Day 4 (Sunday)

Free time followed by check out of Hotel Saratoga at midday.

Lunch at a traditional Mallorcan restaurant

We will be going to a traditional Mallorcan restaurant where we will have time to experience what it is like to have Sunday Lunch in Mallorca, indulging in a spot of sobremesa (Spanish for having a jolly good chat.)
